

Town of Litchfield, New Hampshire

PARKING ORDINANCE

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Litchfield, New Hampshire:

1. No person shall park, or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on the west side of Brickyard Drive in its entirety.
2. No person shall park, or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on either side of Brickyard Drive over the culvert. This area is distinguished by a guardrail on both sides of the roadway.
3. No person shall park, or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on north side of Nakomo Drive from corner of Brickyard Drive to #9 Nakomo Drive.
4. No person shall park or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on the south side of Nakomo Drive within 150 feet from the corner of Brickyard Drive.
5. In addition to other penalties, fines or violations imposed under this Ordinance, all vehicles found in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by order of the Litchfield Police Department. The costs of such removal and of subsequent storage of a removed vehicle shall be paid by the vehicle owner prior to release of such vehicle to said owner.
6. The area designated in Section 1-4 shall be marked by the posting of "No Parking" signs at each end of the prohibited parking zone.
7. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of the Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) fine payable to the Town of Litchfield for the first offense. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance subsequent to a first offense shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine payable to the Town of Litchfield.
8. This ordinance replaces all ordinances previously approved in 2008 and 2009 for purposes of limiting parking on Brickyard and Nakomo Drives.

This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2011.



1. No person shall park, or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on the North side of Nakomo Drive from the corner of Brickyard Drive to #9 Nakomo Drive.
2. In addition to other penalties, fines or violations imposed under this Ordinance, all vehicles found in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by order of the Litchfield Police Department. The costs of such removal and of subsequent storage of a removed vehicle shall be paid by the vehicle owner prior to release of such vehicle to said owner.
3. The area designated in Section 1 shall be marked by the posting of "No Parking" signs at each end of the prohibited parking zone.
4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) fine payable to the Town Of Litchfield for the first offense. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance subsequent to a first offense shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine payable to the Town Of Litchfield.

2. In addition to other penalties, fines or violations imposed under this Ordinance, all vehicles found in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by order of the Litchfield Police Department. The costs of such removal and of subsequent storage of a removed vehicle shall be paid by the vehicle owner prior to release of such vehicle to said owner.
3. The area designated in Section 1 shall be marked by the posting of "No Parking" signs at each end of the prohibited parking zone.
4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) fine payable to the Town Of Litchfield for the first offense. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance subsequent to a first offense shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine payable to the Town Of Litchfield.

**The State of New Hampshire
Town of Litchfield
Election Day Parking Ordinance**

Pursuant to RSA § 41:11, RSA § 41:11-a, RSA § 41:11-b and RSA § 47:17, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Litchfield hereby adopts the following election day parking ordinance.

Between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM or the time set specifically for the election event, no person or operator of a motor vehicle, bus, truck, or tractor-trailer unit shall cause the same to be parked within the election event parking area for more than forty-five (45) minutes (or the longest time it takes a reasonable person to vote as determined by the Moderator).

This ordinance applies to any polling place selected by the Board of Selectmen pursuant to RSA § 658:9 to host an election event where parking must be managed in the interest of safety and voter access.

For purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

The term "polling place" is defined as the public location at which the Board of Selectmen has designated voting to take place during an election event.


The term "election event" is defined as any federal, state, county, or local election, including without limitation, the state general election, the state primary election, the presidential primary election, and the election of town officers.

The term "election event parking area" is defined as the collection of parking spaces or the area specifically designated for voter parking at a polling place as determined by the Board of Selectmen or their appointed safety or other qualified personnel.


The Moderator shall have the power to grant exemptions to this ordinance at his or her discretion. In the event that the Moderator is unavailable, the Assistant Moderator shall have such authority.

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and will have their car towed at the owner's expense. **Adopted: 2 March 2009**







PARKING ORDINANCE

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Litchfield, New Hampshire:

1. No person shall park, or cause to be parked, any vehicle or trailer at any time on the east side of Albuquerque Avenue, from Woodhawk Way, northerly to the north end of Grouse Lane, and on the west side of Albuquerque Avenue at the intersection of Woodhawk Way, to the north end of Stark Lane.
2. In addition to other penalties, fines or violations imposed under this Ordinance, all vehicles found in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by order of the Litchfield Police Department. The costs of such removal and of subsequent storage of a removed vehicle shall be paid by the vehicle owner prior to release of such vehicle to said owner.
3. The area designated in Section 1 shall be marked by the posting of "No Parking" signs at each end of the prohibited parking zone.
4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Twenty-five Dollar (\$25.00) fine payable to the Town of Litchfield for the first offense. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance subsequent to a first offense shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine payable to the Town of Litchfield.

This Ordinance shall take effect on September 1, 1987.
