**River Access sub-committee report**

Jayson Brennen, Pete Psalidas, and Rep. Rich Lascelles were present. Jayson gave out handouts of the properties the committee has visited. He went over the rationale and different scenarios for each parcel. The committee felt that the town owned property at 296 Charles Bancroft Hwy. far and away came out as the top parcel for river access. He then showed how long the drive would have to be. Rich L. has talked to a couple of local people that would donate material for a driveway to the river. A NHDOT permit would be needed when the location for access is certain.

Joan spoke to the town consulting engineer regarding access. Our engineer thought the shorter route would be to access along the southern property line.

There was discussion regarding the farm field and how river access would affect the ability to farm that field.

Jayson will mark up another plan showing two different locations for the drive. Rich may be able to get the costs related to both locations.
