(7:01) Tom calls the meeting to begin and names Andrew T. as a voting member.

(7:03) Jessica and Robert Edwards from Edwards Auto Repair are introduced. They are applying for a special exception to section 1208.01 of Litchfield Zoning on March 13, 2019 for a building constructed in 1968. Tom motions to approve and Joan seconds. Roger motions to write a letter of approval. Vote is 6 yes, all members present.

(7:07) Tom calls for any public input, none is given.

(7:08) Matt discusses adoption of rules of conduct in conservation areas. He wrote up some rules to adopt. One suggestion is to have some signs showing distances from animals for making noise. Check NH Fish and Game for any signs that may be available.

(7:12) Rainfall report by Roger. 14.75 inches of snow and 2.62 inches of rain in February. Low temperature was -2°F on the 2nd and high was 33°F on the 25th.

(7:13) Joan discusses SCA correspondence. They would send crews of 6-7 plus 2 trained leaders to complete conservation area projects. They can be hired for 11 days. Potential area might be Parker Park. Joan will follow up on if there is pricing involved.

(7:22) Approval of February minutes where Roger motions to approve and Harry seconds. Vote is 5 yes (JM, TL, HM, RS, AT), 1 abstain (ML)
